**Year 2013 KMDC Annual Dinner
Free For Current Members!!**

I am pleased to inform you that the 2013 KMDC Annual Dinner will be held on Wednesday, 15th May, 2013 at World Trade Centre Club Hong Kong.

KMDC is delighted to hold this event, not only as a tradition, but also to express our appreciation to members and their associates for their past support. It also serves as an opportunity allowing our members to connect with friends or to mingle with fellow members and KM practitioners. Our EXCO will also share with you the coming activities of KMDC. The cost of this dinner is **HK\$500 per person.**

 - Census and Statistics Department, one of the earliest government departments, has started its KM journey more than 10 years ago. Its KM system has been recognized by other government departments and MAKE award.
3. Mr Simon Yip, Senior Consultant, Hong Kong Productivity Council
 - HKPC has been partnered with KMDC in promoting KM since 2000. We had collaborated several highly successful KM Diploma Program. As our former executive committee member, Simon was also the KM task force leader in HKPC's winning of the Asian and Hong Kong MAKE award 2012.
4. Mr Frankie Lai, Manager, Knowledge Management & Training Office, Huawei Technologies Company Ltd.
 - As one of the world's largest telecommunications equipment providers, Huawei may be a new comer in the KM field. However, once they are committed to implement KM, they learn how to do it from the KM gurus and institutionalize KM practices throughout the organization.
